Through her culinary business, she has served as a personal chef for fashion designer Ralph and Ricky Lauren, supermodel Christie Brinkley and the publishers of TIME Magazine, Kelo and Jo Sutton. Creating fantastic Southwest French fusion cuisine, Ms. Wilcox has adapted premier French recipes into healthier, lighter dishes that have satisfied myriad customers. She also expanded her services as a catering company to several entities, such as weddings, private jet cuisines, farmer's markets and sporting events. Additionally, she has donated her culinary acumen to various charitable endeavors.

Furthermore, Ms. Wilcox established Mountain Meadows Retreat in 2020 during the coronavirus pandemic to create a unique venue site for weddings, parties, family reunions and other celebrations.
